## Eric Holcomb (R)



- ★ Believes **"IN runs on coal"** and calls for a slower transition toward renewables.
- ★ Supports Trump loosening regulations on coal-fired power plants.
- ★ Scheduled timber sale in the Yellowwood Backcountry area, which is among the only remaining wild areas in IN.

## Woody Myers (D)



- ★ Promises to restore the Division of Forestry budget to better reforestation efforts.
- ★ Seeks to create renewable energy rebates, grants, & credits to incentivize clean energy & speed retirement of coal plants.
- ★ Looking to increase IN's forested area from 5 mil acres to 7.5 mil to offset CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.
